

## **BUSINESS AND NON-INSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS**

### **Food Service**

Aims and objectives of the school lunch program are as follows:

1. To make it possible for every pupil to have a nutritionally adequate lunch.
2. To make the maximum contribution to the educational experience of pupils.
3. To be non-profit and to offer a minimum of competition to commercial firms.
4. To maintain high standards in all phases of the program.

The Board has established the school lunch program as an integral part of the total school program. The following guidelines are established:

1. The school lunch program will operate on a non-profit basis.
2. Strict compliance with all laws and regulations pertaining to health, sanitation, and safety, internal accounts, employment practices, dietary components, cost of lunches, and periodic reporting is required.
3. The school lunch program will be conducted as an additional learning experience for pupils.
4. School personnel are not eligible to be served without cost.

The Superintendent is responsible for the administration and operation of the school lunch program in keeping federal and state laws and the policies and directives of the Board.
