

Internal Board Policies - Methods of OperationAdoption, Amendment or Suspension of Policies

- A. Proposed policies introduced and recommended to the Board will be considered at two regular Board of Education meetings. The first consideration will be for discussion and review only. The Board of Education may consider approval at the second meeting.
- B. Proposed policies shall require a majority vote of the Board for adoption and if so passed shall take effect immediately.
- C. Any policy of the Board may be suspended for an agreed upon period of time by a majority vote of the members of the Board.
- D. The Superintendent of Schools, in case of emergency or to comply with legal requirements, may suspend any part of these policies and regulations as it pertains to administration of schools provided, however, that the Superintendent shall report the fact and the reason for such suspension at the next meeting of the Board of Education and, provided further that the suspension shall expire at the time of said report unless continued in effect by action of the Board of Education.
