GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

As a member of the KidsCare team, you will be working in SPCS elementary schools during the school year, Monday-Friday 6:30-8:15am/9:15am, 3:00-6:00pm. Our goal is to greet families and children daily, and establish and maintain positive relationships in a safe, fun environment. You will lead enrichment and STEM activities, group games, outside play...and the occasional classic board game.

WHAT WE'RE LOOKING FOR:

- A sincere desire and interest in working with children
- Leadership and communication skills to manage and appropriately interact with groups of children.
- Ability to uphold program policies and procedures.
- Must be willing to provide availability to work snow and non-school days.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be at least 18 years of age and of good moral character.
- Pass background checks and must meet **ONE** of the following requirements outlined in the DHHS Licensing Handbook:
 1. Hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in early childhood education, education or child/youth development;
 2. Hold an associate degree from an accredited college or university in early childhood education, education or child/youth development;
 3. Have a Child Development Associate Credential; or
 4. Have a high school diploma or GED; and (1) 1500 verified clock hours of experience in organized group activities for school-age children as indicated by a positive reference from a former employer or supervisor; or (2) Submit a written

plan for Department approval to acquire at least three credit hours or 45 clock hours of training in administration, early childhood education, education, or child/youth development, in a period not to exceed six months. The licensee must maintain a copy of the written plan and Department approval for Department review.

- willing to take 12 hours of annual training including CPR/First Aid Certification and must complete Pediatric CPR and First Aid and Prepare to Care trainings.
- Ability to react and move quickly, indoors and outdoors in various weather conditions and otherwise fully participate in activities with children.
